Part IV: Benefit-Cost Analysis

Perhaps a better summary measure for benefit-cost analysis is net benefits, derived by subtracting net costs from net benefits In this way, programs show a positive return on investment if net benefits are greater than zero This summary measure is less easily manipulated in terms of how costs and benefits are labeled and thus is the preferred
